Chapter One:

The Foundation: My Relationship with God

The basis for living the abundant life that God intended for you to live starts with a personal intimate relationship with God. God not only wants you to know Him as your Creator and Savior, He also wants you to know Him as your Heavenly Father, closest friend, and first love.

In Christ...

I am saved

I confess with my mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in my heart that God raised him from the dead, and I am saved (Rom. 10:9, NIV). God saved me by his special favor when I believed. And I can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things I have done, so I can't boast about it (Eph. 2:8, 9, NLT).

I am forgiven

When I was dead in my sins and the uncircumcision of my sinful nature, God made me alive with Christ. He forgave all my sins, having cancelled the written code, with its regulations, that was against me and that stood opposed to

me; he took it away nailing it to the cross (Col. 2:13, 14, NIV).

I am a child of God

Because I am a child of God (son/daughter), God sent the Spirit of his Son into my heart, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father." So I am no longer a slave, but a child of God; and since I am a child of God, God has made me also an heir (Gal. 4:6, 7, NIV).

Chapter Two:

Jesus Came to Give Me Abundant Life

Jesus died for you so that you can enjoy life and receive all the promises and blessings that are made available to you as His child. He wants you to live your life to the fullest with true fulfillment in Him.

In Christ...

I am fulfilled

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. Jesus came that I may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows) (John 10:10, Amp.)

I am prosperous

My delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law—the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God—I habitually meditate (ponder and study) by day and by night. I shall be like a tree firmly planted (and tended) by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither, and everything I do shall prosper (and come to maturity) (Ps. 1:2, 3, Amp.)

I am joyful

I have not seen Christ, but still I love him. I cannot see him now, but I believe in him. So I am filled with a joy that cannot be explained, a joy full of glory (1 Peter 1:8, NCV).

Chapter Three:

KEY LIFE AREA #1:

God gives me...

Love for Life, Self, and Others

God is love and nothing can separate you from His love. When you have a relationship with Him, you will be able to receive His love and love Him in return with all your heart. Barriers in our heart such as unforgiveness, bitterness, offenses, anger, etc., block our ability to receive God's love. When the barriers are removed His love will freely flow through us to love life, self, and others.

In Christ...

I am rooted and grounded in love

Lord, strengthen me with might through Your Spirit in the inner man...that being rooted and grounded in love...I may know the love of Christ which passes knowledge and that I may be filled with all the fullness of God (Eph. 3:16-19).

I am loved

For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate me from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus my Lord (Romans 8:38, 39).

I am loving

I love others, for love is of God and I am born of God and know God (1 John 4:7, 8).

Chapter Four:

KEY LIFE AREA #2:

God gives me...

Purpose in Living

God leads and guides you concerning His will, plan, and purpose for your life. He directs your every step as you trust in Him. He shows you the path of life.

In Christ...

I am significant

Christ gives meaning to my life (Christ is my life) (Col. 3:4a, CEV). I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself for me (Gal. 2:20).

I am purposeful

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future” (Jeremiah 29:11, NIV).

I am God's workmanship

For I am God's (own) handiwork (His workmanship), recreated in Christ Jesus, (born anew) that I may do those good works which God predestined (planned beforehand) for me, (taking paths which He prepared ahead of time) that I should walk in them—living the good life which He prearranged and made ready for me to live (Eph. 2:10, Amp.).

Chapter Five:

KEY LIFE AREA #3:

God gives me...

Enduring Hope

You have an ever-living hope. Because Jesus was raised from the dead, you have been given a brand new life. And you have everything to live for here on earth as well as a glorious future in heaven to look forward to.

In Christ...

I am hopeful

The God of hope fills me with all joy and peace in believing, that I may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 15:13). And now Lord, what do I wait for and expect? My hope and expectation are in You (Ps. 39:7, Amp.).

I am faithfilled

I live by faith, not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7). By faith, I believe that God exists and that He cares enough to respond to me as I seek Him (Hebrews 11:6, Msg.).

I am trusting God

I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in His word I do hope (Ps. 130:5). But as for me, I trust in You, O Lord; I say, "You are my God." My times are in Your hand (Ps. 31:14, 15a).

Chapter Six:

KEY LIFE AREA #4:

God gives me...

Perfect Peace

Jesus is the source of true peace. He is the Prince of Peace. You can have God's perfect peace not only when everything is going well in your life but also when you are in the midst of trails and storms. As you keep your mind focused on Him, He will keep you in perfect peace.

In Christ...

I am carefree

I don't worry about anything, but I pray about everything. With a thankful heart I offer up my prayers and requests to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard my heart and mind through Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:6, 7, CEV, NKJV).

I am sound minded

I let the peace of God rule in my heart (Col. 3:15b, NCV).

God has not given me a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7).

I am a peacemaker

I want to enjoy life and see good days ahead...so I search for peace—harmony; undisturbedness from fears, agitating passions and moral conflicts—and seek it eagerly. I do not merely desire peaceful relations [with God, with my fellowmen, and with myself], but I pursue and go after them! (1 Peter 3:10, 11, Amp.).

Chapter Seven:

KEY LIFE AREA #5:

God helps me to have a...

Positive Thought Life

Developing a positive thought life starts with renewing your mind. When God lives inside of you, you are spiritually reborn. However, your mind isn't. It must be renewed by studying, meditating, and applying God's word.

In Christ...

I am positive and optimistic

I fill my mind and meditate on things true, noble, reputable, authentic, compelling, gracious—the best, not the worst; the beautiful, not the ugly; things to praise, not things to curse (Phil. 4:8, Msg.).

I am renewed

...with regard to my former way of life, I put off my old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; I am made new in the attitude of my mind; and I put on the new

self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness (Eph. 4:22-24, NIV).

I am Christ-minded

I have the mind of Christ (1 Cor. 2:16b). For though I walk in the flesh, I do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ (2 Cor. 10:3-5).

Chapter Eight:

KEY LIFE AREA #6:

God helps me to have a...

Healthy Self-Image

As you grow in your relationship with God you will begin to see yourself as God sees you. You will continually be conformed to the image and likeness of Christ and reflect His glory.

In Christ...

I am worthy

Not even a sparrow, worth only half a penny can fall to the ground without my Father knowing it. He pays even greater attention to me, down to the last detail—even numbering the hairs on my head. So I will not be afraid; I am more valuable to him than a whole flock of sparrows (Matt. 10:29-31, NLT, Msg.)

I am special

For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and

wonderfully made; marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well (Ps. 139:13, 14).

I am Christlike

...I can be a mirror that brightly reflects the glory of God. And as the Spirit of the Lord works within me, I become more and more like him and reflect his glory even more (2 Cor. 3:18, NLT).

Chapter Nine:

KEY LIFE AREA #7:

God provides...

Inner Healing of My Soul

God's grace, mercy and love pour out to you when you cry out to Him. He comforts you when you are hurting and holds you in His everlasting arms of love. He heals your pain and restores your broken heart.

In Christ...

I am restored

The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit (Ps. 34:18, NIV). He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. He restores my soul (Ps. 23:2, 3a).

I am healed

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds (Ps. 147:3). But he was pierced for my transgressions, he was crushed for my iniquities; the punishment that

brought me peace was upon him, and by his wounds I am healed (Isaiah 53:5, NIV).

I am free

Jesus said...if I abide in His word, I am His disciple indeed. And I shall know the truth, and the truth shall make me free (John 8:32).

Chapter Ten:

KEY LIFE AREA #8:

God gives me...

A Thankful Heart

When you give thanks to God from the depths of your heart you are praising and glorifying God for who He is and for all He has done in your life.

In Christ...

I am thankful

I rejoice always, pray without ceasing, and in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for me (1 Thess. 5:16-18). I give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever (Ps. 107:1).

I am content

I enjoy my work and accept my lot in life—it is a gift from God. I don't need to look back with sorrow on my past, for God gives me joy (Eccl. 5:19b-20, TLB).

I am a worshipper

I am a true worshipper and I worship the Father in spirit and in truth (John 4:23, 24). I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth (Ps. 34:1).

To live the victorious Christian life we have established the importance of having a relationship with God as foundational.
